Bexley, Erith, Kent	 Redhouse Premium Copper-coloured best bitter with roast and sweet orange marmalade. Dry finish with a touch of chocolate in finish and aroma.	4.2% Amber Ale
	 Anchor Bay IPA A deep golden beer with a fruity, citrus taste and a floral, spicy aroma. Brewed with a blend of Mosaic and Cascade hops from the USA.	4.8% Golden Ale
Binghams, Ruscombe, Berkshire	 Macchiato Stout A smooth, dark stout infused with vanilla and coffee.	5.0% Stout
	 Space Hoppy IPA Pale golden in colour and packed with hops to create a complex flavour and a long citrus finish.	5.0% Pale Ale
Crafty Brewing, Dunsfold, Surrey	 Five Hop IPA A soft combination of lychee and melon notes that straddles the delicate bitterness of this five-hopped IPA. Dry-hopped with the US hop Ekuano.	4.0% Pale Ale
Fisher's, High Wycombe, Buckinghamshire	 Smoked Porter Coffee, chocolate and wood smoke define this traditional porter. Fresh, zesty Centennial and Chinook hops keep it light and drinkable.	4.4% Porter
	 English Pale Ale Made with Jester, Cascade, Ollicana and Mystic UK hops from the UK, this IPA is clean, dry and refreshing.	5.0% Pale Ale
Loddon, Dunsden, Oxfordshire	 Hoppit Hops dominate the aroma of this drinkable session beer. Malt and hops create a balanced taste and a pleasant bitterness carries through to the aftertaste.	3.5% Pale Ale
	 N.O.T.U.S. An amber-coloured, American style pale ale with a good balance between malt and hops. Some biscuit notes accompany a fruity taste, leading to a bitter finish.	4.7% Pale Ale
Malt, Prestwood, Buckinghamshire	 Missenden Pale Ale Light amber coloured, hoppy session ale.	3.6% Amber Ale
	 Starry Nights Light and fruity amber-coloured ale.	4.0% Amber Ale
Portobello, North Kensington, London W10	 Autumn Red Deep red beer with flavours of berries, roasted coffee and hazelnut.	4.4% Red Ale
	 American Pale Ale Full bodied, straw-coloured strong ale. The honey sweetness and soft citrus fruit balanced by bitter hops. Dry aftertaste.	5.0% Pale Ale
Rebellion, Marlow Bottom, Buckinghamshire	 Smuggler A reddish-coloured beer, full-bodied and bitter with an uncompromisingly dry, bitter finish.	4.2% Red Ale
	 Roasted Nuts A deep ruby-coloured, complex beer packed with intense malt and hop character.	4.6% Ruby Ale
Reunion, Feltham, Greater London	 Beardtongue Best bitter with a chocolate and damson aroma and flavour with some honey. Lingering sweet finish with dry cocoa.	4.5% Dark Amber Ale
	 Incredible Pale Ale Smooth beer with honey sweetness overlaid with a mix of fruits. Earthy hop character is present throughout. Bitter finish.	5.0% Amber Ale
Thames Side, Staines-upon-Thames, Surrey	 Black Swan Porter Rich and malty, but nicely balanced historical London porter.	4.6% Porter
	 Wryneck Rye IPA Spicy but hoppy Rye IPA.	5.6% Amber Ale
Vale, Brill, Buckinghamshire	 Black Beauty Porter The initial aroma is malty. Roast malt dominates initially and is followed by a rich fruitiness, with some sweetness. The finish is increasingly hoppy and dry.	4.4% Porter
	 Gravitas A strong pale ale packed with hop and citrus flavours, rounded off by a dry, malty, biscuit finish.	4.8% Pale Ale

White Horse, Stanford-in-the-Vale, Oxfordshire	 Wayland Smithy Dark copper ale with toasty aroma, caramel, malt and biscuit flavours balanced by a spicy hop finish.	4.4% Dark Copper Ale
	 Show Pony A pale/red ale with a floral, tropical fruit aroma and a crisp, grapefruit/mango taste.	4.5% Light Red Ale
Windsor & Eton, Windsor, Berkshire	 Knight of the Garter Hoppy golden ale with grapefruit notes. Dry, refreshing finish.	3.8% Golden Ale
	 Conqueror A black IPA. Malty and hoppy with berry notes. A full, rounded, slightly dry finish.	5.0% Dark Ale
Crouch Vale, South Woodham Ferrers, Essex	 Discovery A pale session ale packed with Chinook hops – ideally complementing the Indian Summer.	3.8% Golden Ale
	 Amarillo A premium golden ale with aromas of Amarillo hops and a lasting spicy and orangey flavour. Cara malt provides a little burnished colour, but the light body belies its strength.	5.0% Golden Ale
Maldon Brewing Co, Maldon, Essex	 Fountain of Salmacis A blonde beer with citrus/lemon undertones.	3.9% Golden Ale
	 Panta A golden craft beer (brewed under the Blackwater Brewhouse banner) bursting with tropical aromas from Citra and Mosaic hops. Naturally hazy (vegan friendly).	5.0% Golden Ale
Mighty Oak, Maldon, Essex	 Bone Picker A pale ale full of fruity flavours from the amazing Jarrylo hop imparting banana, pear and spice.	3.9% Pale Ale
	 Game Over Fruity Mistral and Ollicana hops abound and are well balanced by pale chocolate malts.	3.9% Amber Ale
Watson's, Colchester, Essex	 Quintanilla Strong porter with borage honey from the bees at Abbots Hall Farm, near Colchester.	7.3% Porter
	 8 Grain Imperial American Stout A hoppy imperial stout in the American style with a complex grain bill.	6.9% Stout
